Now it might sound a bit like a stuck record to say the question of whether or not to have female pastors will be on the agenda this year. What Convention for the past 30 years has not addressed this subject! But this year, there is talk of the Church splitting if some people don't get their way.

Talk of a split evokes images of the bad old days, pre 1966, when Lutheran children were raised to have nothing to do with people from the 'other synod', and where people who married across the divide were regarded as taking on a 'mixed marriage'!

I was just old enough to remember what it felt like to be in a 'split' church. I remember as a 4 year old attending the other synod's church in Lobethal, even then with a sense of curiosity, that we didn't belong there, and that we probably wouldn't do something so naughty again. The strongest memory actually was of wearing the preacher's spittle if you sat in the front row (as I guess we must have).

Our rep, Glenis Kupke (for the TLH Congregation) will tell all when she returns. The Convention goes for 3 or so days, and we wish her good health, wisdom and stamina. She'll truly be among friends and will receive many blessings from being part of this historic event. I personally would love to see meaningful change while the split, if there is one, is contained. Whatever the outcome, we at LHB will treat every resident the same, welcoming all regardless of their (church) politics. We live in interesting times, and it is within our power to make them the best of times, because Christ is among us and his Spirit unites us all in 'One Body'. Yes, we have reason to be optimistic!
