Connections; Boy, do we have them in abundance here at Lutheran Homes Barossa! Every time I turn around, I am delighted to find that someone is related to someone else here, or that they went to school together, or that they were neighbours. In a small country area like ours, and in this Home in particular, we have plenty of opportunities to reacquaint ourselves with old friends or neighbours; visit direct family members or catch up with cousins within our walls.

My own mother was here at LHB 2017-18 and some still remember her, not just from her time as a resident, but from her time as a music teacher at both Nuriootpa and Kapunda High School. She taught one of our residents' children and she played music with some from the Home here. She used to bring students into the Home for concerts too. I, myself, went to school with some of the children of residents, and I am also a neighbour to one of our residents' daughters. A small world indeed and don't I love it.

Connection is what makes community a <u>real</u> community I reckon. We all like to feel we are known and have some sense of fitting into our environment. We all ask the question; Where do I fit in? Knowing others and being known by others is essential to feeling good in our current situation as we humans are created for connection. Of course, there are many who come in knowing no one, and that is where we are encouraged to reach out to others so that they remain strangers for as little time as possible. It is part of the Christian ethos to "welcome the stranger among you" and draw them into a sense of family. This is what some of the Lifestyle activities encourage too, as do the services we offer each week. We are also all called brothers and sisters to one another in the faith. Our aim is that of Christ's; to be that "loving Christian community" who welcomes and extends grace to all of us who count Adam and Eve as our parents.
