

Many highly dramatic stories begin something like: "It began as a beautiful day ..." Sometimes the surface impression is all we need, and the great day remains a great day. Sometimes the great start provides the back-drop for all kinds of accidents, arguments, mis-interpretations or the continuation of struggle.

The lead up to Christmas may be naively happy for some, and we sometimes put a lot of energy into ensuring it stays like that. But Jesus' coming was always set against the backdrop of a suffering community in need of a Saviour of some kind, or at least some assurance that this old world should end soon so that something much better might replace it. 


GENERAL STORE


COURTYARD CAFE

CHRISTMAS FETE 2024




